Full Assembly Plenary Meetings
Gives all 112 members the chance to debate and agree policies and actions
Take place three times a year in locations across the region
Members of the public are able to attend as observers

Executive Committee
Carries out Assembly business between full Assembly meetings
31 members
Meets six times a year
Members of the public are able to attend as observers

Scrutiny Role

Select Committees
Examine different aspects of SEEDA's work.
There are three committees a year each comprising approximately nine members
Each committee meets once or twice.
Meetings are open to the public

Environment Agency Dialogue Meeting
Ensures environment priorities reflect the region's needs
Meets annually
These meetings are not open to the public

Health Summit
Ensures health priorities reflect the region's needs
Members include the Chairmen of: the Assembly, the Regional Planning Committee and the Regional Housing Board
Meets three times a year
These meetings are not open to the public

Regional Transport Board
Partnership board drawing members from the Assembly and stakeholder organisations to advise Government on regional transport priorities

12 members (six from the Assembly)

Meets approximately four times a year

Members of the public are able to attend as observers

Regional Planning Committee
Advises the Executive Committee and the full Assembly on matters relating to the Assembly's Regional Planning role

26 members (can include external members)

Meets approximately six times a year

Members of the public are able to attend as observers

Regional Housing Board
Partnership board drawing members from the Assembly and stakeholder organisations to advise Government on housing priorities

10 members (six from the Assembly)

Meets approximately four times a year

Members of the public are able to attend as observers

Advisory Groups
These comprise officers from local authorities and stakeholders. Groups provide technical and policy support for Assembly staff, feeding into recommendations and advice for Assembly members.
